

E85 Highway Sign Grant Application Form

Fuel retailers selling E85 along Wisconsin's State Highway Corridor can apply for grants for placement on the state's blue informational highway exit signs. Grants awarded through this program are intended to provide the initial graphic fee and one year of rent on the Department of Transportation's blue "Gas" signage located at the nearest local highway exit.

NOTE: Offer is limited to the first 25 eligible stations to submit an application, as funding allows. Application for the grant does NOT constitute automatic acceptance into the highway sign program. Applicants must meet program specifications, as set by the Wisconsin DOT and Derse-WHBS.
